

Guidelines for ATW Eco-Aviation Awards Submission Nominations

Your proposal for any of ATW's Eco-Aviation Awards should include:

1. An executive cover letter summing up eco-achievements
2. Highlights on any industry-wide/collaborative eco efforts
3. Highlights of any 'firsts'
4. Highlights of any R&D or scientific efforts/collaborative work that address biofuel source sustainability
5. Highlights of any metrics achieved that exceed industry standards
6. Highlight of any customer and/or employee eco awareness efforts.

Entrants should submit two or three short paragraphs against each item, as applicable.

Entrants should attach supporting evidence, including company documents, data tables, press releases, statistical data, and details that will back up any claims made and Web links to supporting sources. Where available, Entrants are encouraged to provide relevant images and short videos.

Entrants should provide a point of contact with full name, title, email, address and phone number.

The ATW Editorial Team will do final judging.
